Delta High School is one of four senior high schools in Delta County School District 50J. Delta County is an agricultural area located on the Western Slope of Colorado. Delta High School has an enrollment of approximately 630 students in grades 9-12. Currently, Delta High School operates on a two-semester school year with 17 weeks per semester. Delta High School uses a seven period day per semester. One half credit is awarded, in each class passed, at the end of the semester.

Graduation Requirements

A total of 24 credits are required to graduate, and are to include the following:

Language Arts	4 Credits
Social Studies	3 Credits (1 American History 1/2 Economics)
Physical Education	1 Credit
Electives	11 Credits

AP courses are weighted; all other courses are given equal weight in the computation of grade point averages. Semester grades are used to figure cumulative grade point average with an average of the following points. Students are assigned a class rank as a result of their cumulative grade point average.
